

Iris longipetala



Iridaceae

Exposure Sun or part shade

Water Occasional water

Form Deciduous perennial

Height 18 inches

Flower color Lavender

Bloom time

This attractive upright growing iris is not commonly available. It differs from other native iris by being more tolerant of regular watering and by being deciduous. Remove dead leaves in early spring for best appearance. Grown in shade or damp spots it needs no summer water. Forms clumps to two feet wide.
