

Mimulus lewisii

Scrophulariaceae

Exposure	Full sun
Water	Constant moisture
Form	Perennial
Height	2 feet
Flower color	Pink
Bloom time	Summer



This mimulus bears a succession of large pink flowers over a long period, then dies to the ground over the winter. The leaves are softly hairy. This is a challenging plant to grow in open ground but it grows well in a pot when kept moist with a water-filled saucer. It hybridizes with *Mimulus cardinalis*, resulting in offspring with a variety of flower shapes and colors.
