

Ribes sanguineum 'King Edward VII'

Red Flowering Currant

Grossulariaceae



Exposure Sun or part shade

Water Occasional water

Form Deciduous shrub

Height 8 to 12 feet

Flower color Pink

Bloom time Spring



In early spring this currant bears abundant clusters of pink flowers that are visited by humming birds. In summer the flowers are followed by dark blue berries with a white blush. This selection from outside California was chosen for its dark rose-red flowers. Needs good drainage.
