



CNPS Santa Cruz County Chapter Plant Sale: Spring 2024

Note: due to the unusually chilly and wet winter, certain staple Spring Sale plants are missing from the Availability list because they were not rooted into their containers sufficiently to meet our high standards. Other species we chose to sell in a “lightly rooted” condition rather than eliminate them entirely from the Sale; a week or two of warm and sunny weather will fill out the root ball or you can plant them “as is.” Please ask a CNPS volunteer if you have any questions!
